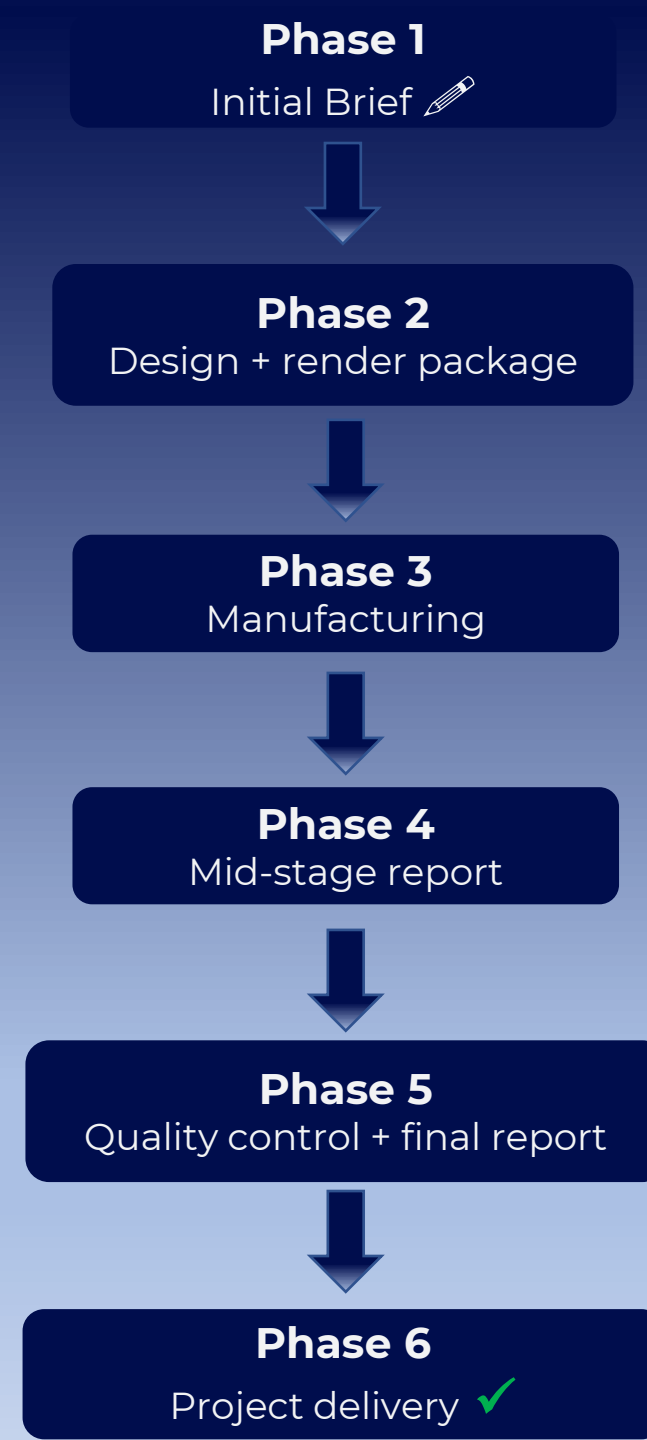

Phase 1 –

Initial Brief

Please include the following items:

- Specification
- Dimensions
- Sketch (if possible) of what you require
- Any events in the near future that we need to be made aware of for manufacturing (*guest trips etc*).

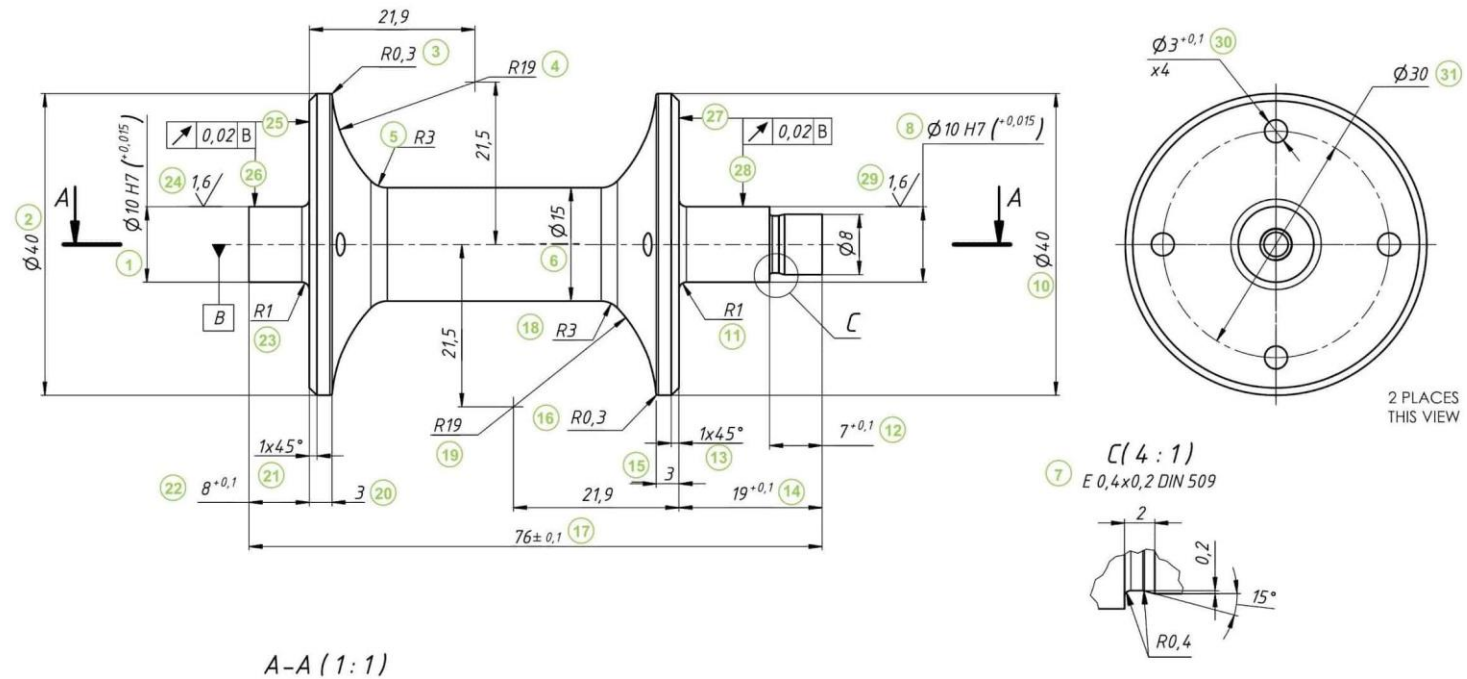

Phase 2 – Design

During the design phase, we will provide you with preliminary designs (to which we will base our quotes and lead time off). The preliminary designs can easily be altered until the final design meets your exact requirements.

Once the initial design work has been completed, we will provide you with a full render package including technical drawings and CAD models allowing you to fully immerse yourself within the project.

The final render package must be signed off with invoice(s) paid* prior to manufacturing.





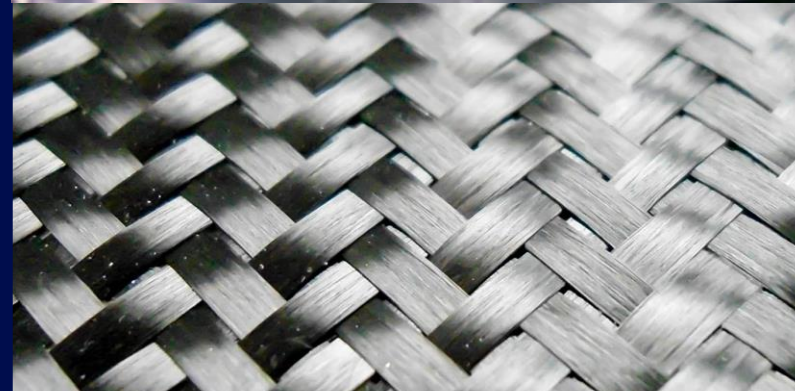

Phase 3 – Manufacturing

Once the final design package has been signed off, we will begin the manufacturing process. We will update you within the first week as to how we are looking on lead times and whether we are on track or not.

- Composites (*carbon fibre, glass fibre, aramid fibre*)
- Wood

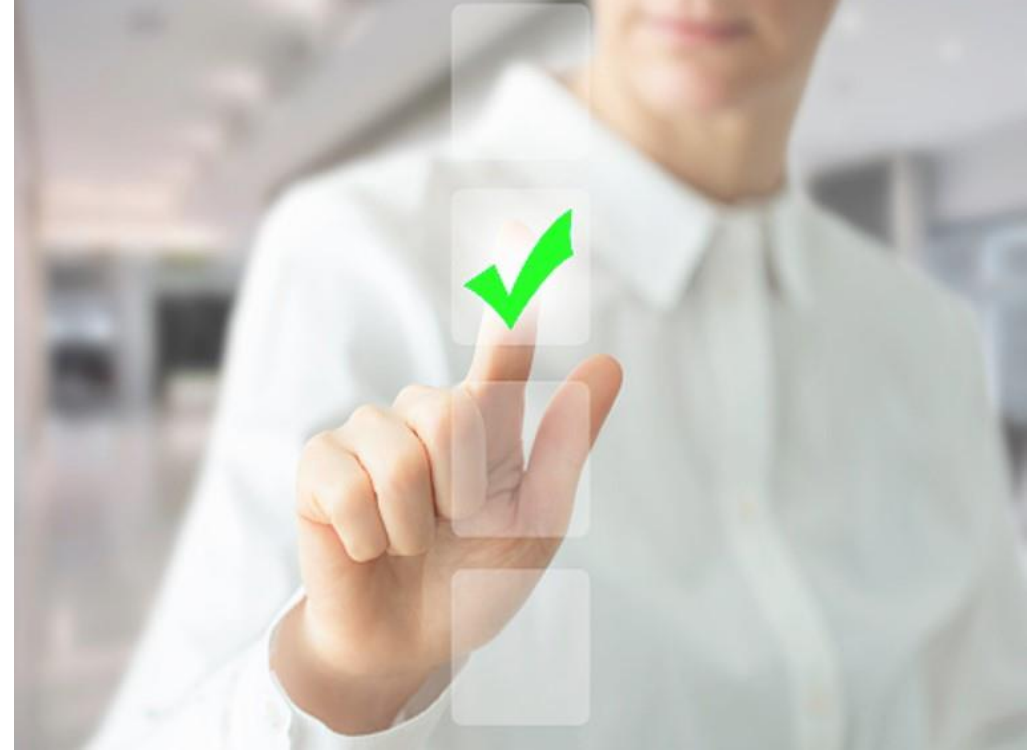
